FIRE AUTHORITY OBLIGATIONS

Provide written information including but not limited to:

- Most recent County Burn Ordinance
- Applicable State Regulations
- County Burn Plan
- Pile construction guide
- Contact info for;
 - Frecom (dispatch) for notification of burn ignition and end of Burn
 - Fire authority locations

Provide burn permit to FRECOM dispatch .

Maintain all open burn permits on file and a current list of all persons registered with respiratory problems with the Custer County Department of Public Health.

OBLIGATIONS OF THE BURN MANAGER (permittee)

- Read and understand the materials provided by the Fire Authority prior to the day of the Burn.
- Notify adjoining land owners of the permit for the proposed burn.
- Notify registered persons with respiratory problems (if any) within 1 mile of the proposed burn date and time.
- Prepare burn items in manageable piles as per the pile construction guide. Burn No more than 3 piles per Burn day of no greater than 512 cubic feet each in any dimensional configuration (unless managed by a certified Burn Boss). The permit is for one year and limited to 50 piles per year and 3 burn piles per day.
- Clear areas around Burn location and maintain setbacks from exposed items to be protected from ignition.
- Provide water source and/or fire suppression materials readily accessible to Burn site. The burn will be attended by the Burn Manager throughout the entire burn process, from ignition to total extinguishment.
- Notify FRECOM dispatch of the time of proposed Burn the day of the burn prior to ignition. Submit the burn plan (if under the supervision of a certified Burn Boss) at the time of application for permit.
- Be certain that the Burn is extinguished and cold by sundown of the Burn day.

By my signature hereon I certify to the Fire Authority that I have received the materials provided and that I will comply with Burn the Manager Obligations defined herein. If any provisions of the burn plan/application, County Open Burn Ordinance, Burn bans or State requirements are violated, I understand that I am subject to the penalties defined in the County Open Burn ordinance. A smoke permit may be required from the State of Colorado and it is my obligation to apply for one. Further, I understand that I am accountable for the safety and results of my open burn activities and may be held responsible for any damages caused to persons or properties outside of the property permitted for the burn activity.
